Summertime Refreshment – Strawberry Lemonade

Ingredients  
4 cups fresh lemon juice  
3 cups sugar  
1 bag frozen strawberries

Squeeze the lemons and pour the juice into a pitcher. Mix together the sugar with 3 cups water and stir to dissolve to make syrup. Add the syrup to the lemon juice and top it up with 8 cups water. Taste to make sure it's sweet enough for you, add the strawberries. Mix the lemonade together and let chill in the fridge. For the adults, add 1 1/2 ounces vodka to each glass (You can substitute raspberries for strawberries but remember they are tart and you June need to increase the sugar.) Fill mason jars with ice cubes and top them off with the lemonade
