Aerie/Auxiliary Enrollment Fees waived – January 2018

Do you know anyone who would like to join the Eagles, or who let their membership lapse and would like to rejoin? Now is the time to sign them up! During the month of January, the Aerie & Auxiliary will continue to waive enrollment fees. The new or re-enrolled applicant only need to pay the membership dues to have them current through May 31, 2018 or 2019.

Cost to join during January:

Aerie - \$10.67 to May 2018, \$42.67 to May 2019

Auxiliary - \$8.34 to May 2018, \$33.34 to May 2019

After that, Aerie dues are \$32 a year.

Auxiliary dues are \$25 per year.

Also, a new member may elect to pay a year in advance when they sign up by adding the yearly dues mentioned above.

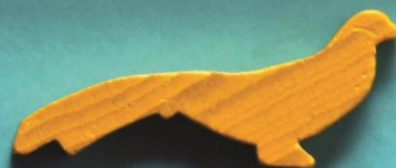
