## **Aerie By-Law Changes Approved**

The proposed Aerie By-Law changes that were previously approved by membership, were approved by the Grand Aerie. The most significant changes are:

**1) Section 2.6 added. Now allows the Junior**

**Past Worthy President to serve as an Aerie Trustee if properly nominated and elected, 2) Section 5, Membership Dues. Yearly Membership Dues for all members have increased from \$32 to \$36 per year.**

**3) Section 9.9, Salary of Aerie employees. Clarified wages for all employees.**

### **Aerie Membership Dues Increase**

Membership Dues for all members are increasing effective 1 Sep 2018, from \$32 to \$36. The initiation fee for new membership is increasing from \$13 to \$15. The re-enrollment fee of \$10 has stayed the same.

The increases were needed due to the increase of Per Capita tax we pay to the Grand Aerie and to simplify the proration of dues for new or re-enrolled members to reach May 31<sup>st</sup>. All membership cards must now expire on 31 May.
