Cost to Become an Eagle Member During December 2018

During November & December, the Aerie & Auxiliary are waiving enrollment fees. The new or re-enrolled applicant only needs to pay the membership dues to May 2019, or May 2020.

Cost to join during December:

Aerie - \$15.00 to May 2019
 \$51.00 to May 2020

Auxiliary - \$10.42 to May 2019
 \$35.42 to May 2020

After that, Aerie dues are \$36 a year. Auxiliary dues are \$25 per year.

Veterans, Law Enforcement, EMTs, Firefighters, etc., receive their first year's membership free. We ask that these new members pay the prorated monthly fees to reach May 2020, since all membership cards now expire May 31st. For an Aerie member that would be \$15.00; Auxiliary \$10.42
