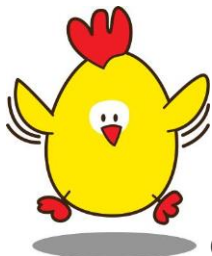

HALLOWEEN BOO BASH & PUB CRAWL!



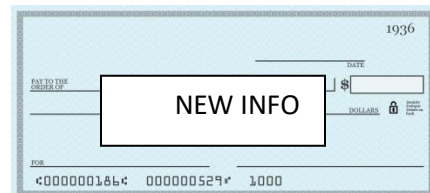
Mark your calendars for Saturday, October 27th and don't miss the Halloween Pub Crawl.

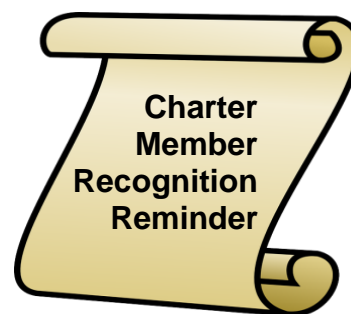
