

Dues Renewal Update

All members of the Fraternal Order of Eagles renewal date is May 31, 2019.

Members are encouraged to renew their dues before May 31, to avoid the possibility of losing their membership status for the 2019-2020 fraternal year.

Paper dues reminders will be mailed to anyone who has not paid their dues by March 25th. Reminders are sent in early April, May and June.

****** To avoid your Aerie or Auxiliary being charged for additional reminders, dues should be renewed no later than April 26th. ******

Those who have not paid by May 31 have 30 days to renew or they risk losing their access to protection through the Fraternal Order of Eagles Memorial Foundation, access to membership benefit savings on car insurance, home insurance, life insurance, travel insurance, car rentals, hotels, cruises, identity theft protection and more.

You can renew your dues by mail or by stopping by your club. **Aerie annual dues are \$36.00 per year, and Auxiliary dues are \$25.00.** Your new expiration date will be 31 May 2020.
