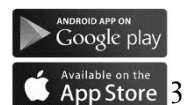

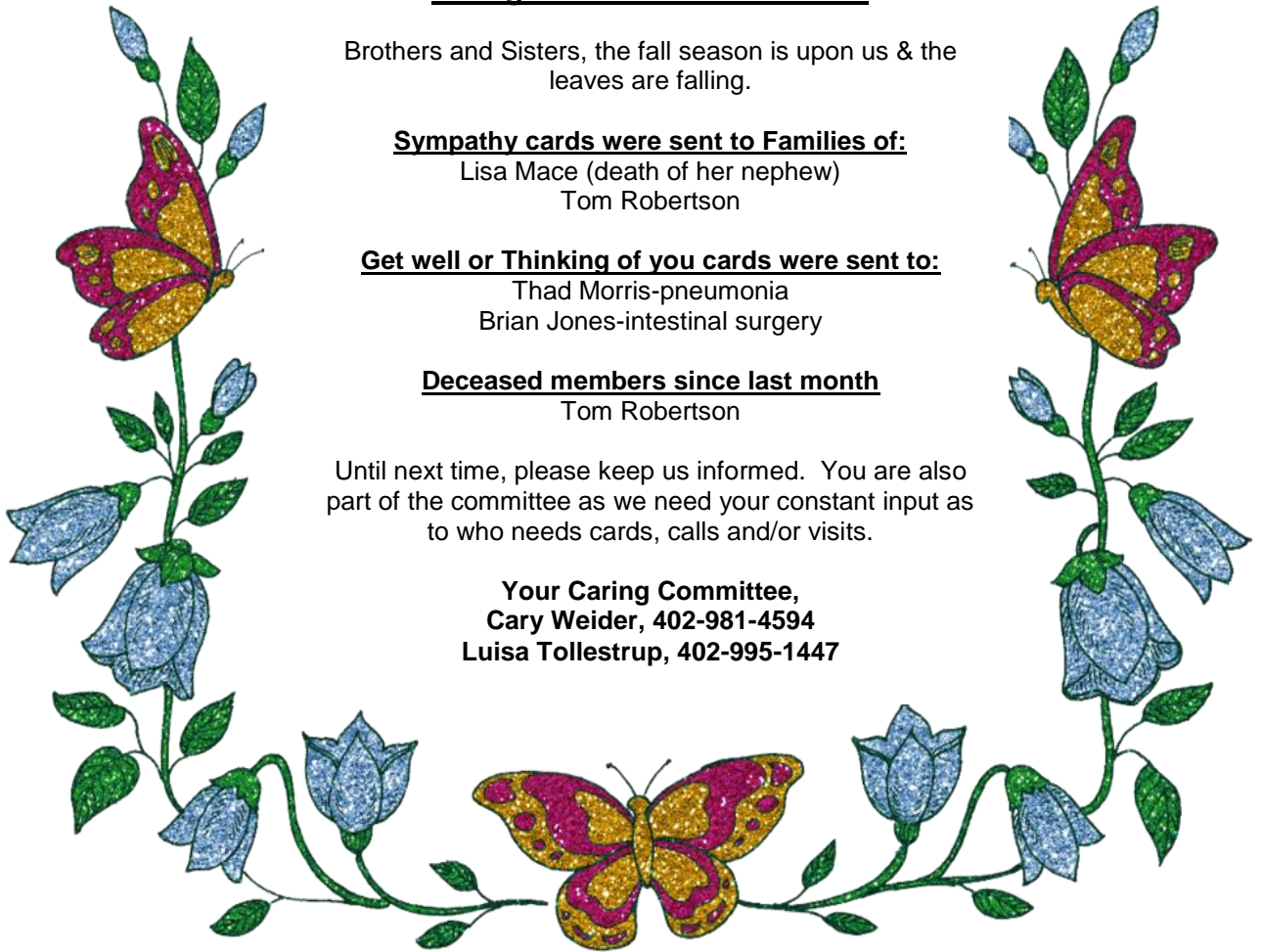

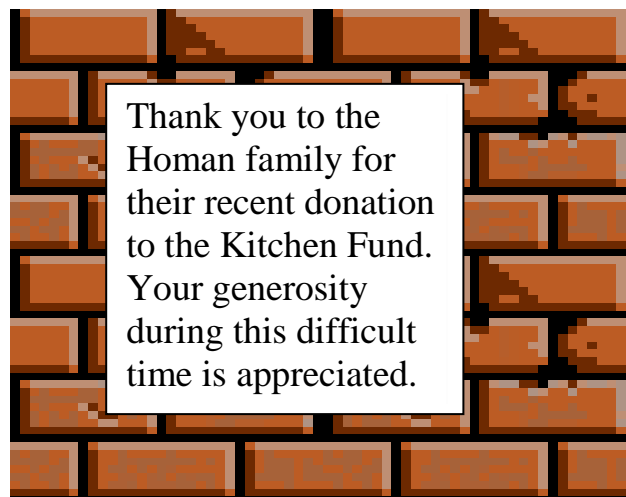
Annual Craft and Home-Based Business Fair – Success!
