**Auxiliary Membership Dues**

New or Re-enrollee-----	\$16.25
Dual Member-----	\$6.25
<b>* Prorated dues to 31 May (Vets)--\$6.25</b>	
<b>Annual Dues-----</b>	<b>\$25.00</b>

After that, Aerie Dues are \$36 a year. Auxiliary Dues are \$25 per year.

*A proper application must be submitted for all new or re-enrolled applicants.*

**\* Veterans, Law Enforcement, EMTs, Firefighters, etc., receive their first year's membership free. We ask that these new members pay a prorated monthly fee to reach May 2020, since all membership cards must now expire May 31<sup>st</sup>. For an Aerie member that would be \$9.00, Auxiliary \$6.25. This will get their membership to 31 May 2021.**




