



A proper application must be submitted for all new or re-enrolled applicants.

Veterans, Law Enforcement, EMTs, Firefighters, etc., receive a year's membership free. We ask that these new members pay a prorated monthly fee to reach May 2020, since all membership cards must now expire May 31st. For an Aerie member that would be \$6.00, Auxiliary \$4.17. You then get 1 year free membership. This will get their membership to 31 May 2021.

After that, Aerie Dues are \$36 a year. Auxiliary Dues are \$25 per year.

MARCH "MADNESS" IS BEGINNING AT THE AERIE


There are many events during this busy, fun month!!
