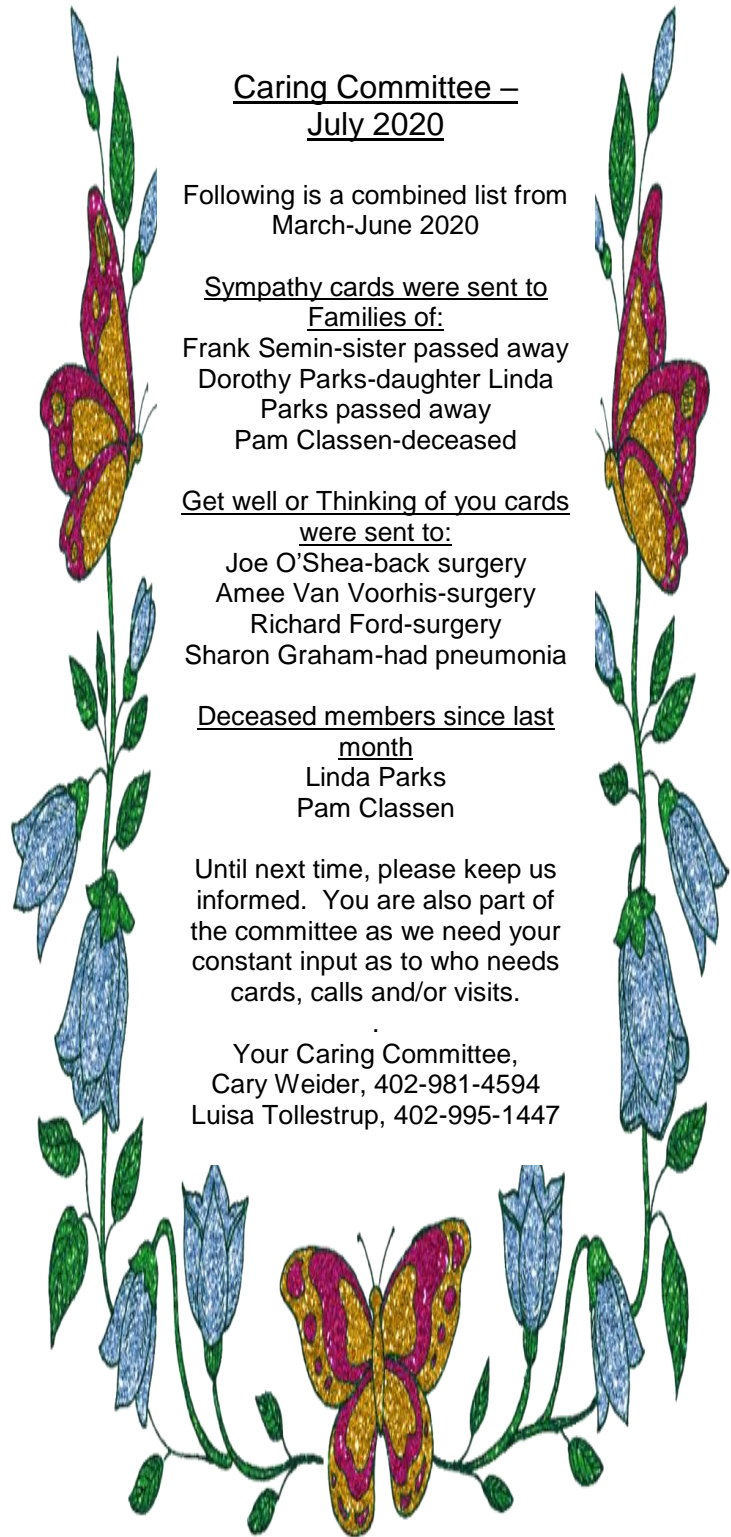

A proper application must be submitted for all new applicants.

Veterans, Law Enforcement, EMTs, Firefighters, etc., receive their first year's membership free. Any dues paid will be prorated to May 31st.

All membership cards now expire May 31st.



If your membership card has an expiration date of 31 May 2020, it has expired and you only have a few days left before you are dropped!

There are still quite a few members who haven't paid their dues. Any members who are delinquent as of June 30th, 2020 will be dropped from the roster on July 10th for "Failure to Pay Dues" by the Grand Aerie.

Aerie annual dues are \$36 per year, and Auxiliary dues are \$25. You can renew your dues by mail or by stopping by the club. Time is running out, renew today!
